REQUIREMENT:

The Canadian Forces have an **URGENT** need for Improvised Explosive Device Disposal (IEDD) explosive ordinance disposal (EOD) threat response for current operations. Defence Research and

Development Canada (DRDC) Suffield, in support of current operations, is developing miniature Remote Neutralization Vehicles (mini-RNV) for EOD/IED neutralization, dismounted reconnaissance, mine warfare operations, among other tasks. DRDC Suffield requires engineering development to support this project. This support will include, but not limited to, design and develop prototype vehicles, system integrate novel payloads developed in-house, drafting, prototype repair, and demonstration support. The primary goal of this contract is to deliver two mini-RNV vehicles based on the current prototypes developed at DRDC. The secondary goal is to support development of custom payloads at DRDC and system integrate those payload onto the mini-RNV. It is anticipated that prototype vehicles will be sent to Canadian Forces Bases (CFB) across Canada and to International Security ISAF/ Task Force Afghanistan (TFA) for testing and evaluation by Canadian Forces (CF) personnel. DRDC will continue to work with the EOD community to develop and demonstrate payloads to CF operators across Canada.

MANDATORY CRITERIA:

a) Compliance with the terms and conditions contained in the solicitation document.
