Construction work started

LASHKARGAH (PAN): Construction work of a dam started in the southern Helmand province to irrigate more than 60,000 hectares of agricultural land. Helmand deputy governor Haji Mirzakowal said in a ceremony that the dam in Nawa district will divert the Helmand River water to farms in the district. He said the construction work will take six months with \$800,000 fund provided by a non-governmental organization. An official of the irrigation department Engineer Khan Agha said the dam will irrigate 65,000 hectares of land in Nawa district
