

Comuzzi salutes Cpl. Boneca

MP Joe Comuzzi (L-Thunder Bay-Superior North) rose in the House of Commons on Tuesday to honour Cpl. Anthony Boneca who was killed in Afghanistan on July 9.

The soldier's parents, Anthony and Shirley Boneca, travelled to Ottawa and were in attendance to hear Comuzzi's speech.

"All Canadians should feel proud of this fine young man from Thunder Bay who made the supreme sacrifice for his country," the MP said.

Comuzzi said that after high school, Anthony, or T-Bone as he was known, joined the Lake Superior Scottish Regiment as a reservist.

His first tour of duty was in Afghanistan and he returned to Thunder Bay safely.

"He then volunteered for another tour and arrived back in Afghanistan in February 2006.

"He never saw Thunder Bay or his parents again," Comuzzi said.

"Our sincere sympathy to his parents, who have honoured us with their presence today."
